Stain Remover: Oxy D.S.T.

Tennis courts require cleaning about once a month. Due to the environmental elements, mold or mildew can grow in shaded areas and corners where organic debris tends to accumulate. Stains, mold and mildew can easily be removed using Oxy D.S.T. and scrubbing with a soft bristled brush.

- Dilute in cold water at a rate of 1:80.
- Available in 4 L.

Gladiator 464

Walk behind sweeper perfect for pre-sweeping courts that are covered in debris such as tennis ball fluff.

- Quiet and not disruptive.
- Up to 2.5 hours of runtime.
- 25" sweeping path.

Labrador XP – Cylindrical

Cylindrical walk behind scrubber perfect for light sweeping and cleaning the court.

- 20" scrubbing path.
- 30% water savings compared to disc machines.
