### Cleaner & Degreaser: Complex Orange

Receiving docks are a busy place where dirt, grease and grime can quickly accumulate on floors and equipment. This causes slippery surfaces and could lead to a workplace injury. Complex Orange is a solvent free cleaner degreaser that quickly emulsifies and removes the toughest dirt and soils.

- Dilute in cold water at a rate of 1:30.
- Available in 4L, 20L & 210L.

### Ice Melt Remover: Film Away

Ice melts are commonly used around receiving docks and tend to get dragged into the receiving area. If left unattended, ice melt residue can damage the concrete floor. Using Film Away can efficiently get rid of the residue while neutralizing the floor. UL ECOLOGO® Certified.

- Available in 4 L.

- Two to three coats recommended.

### Debris Pickup

Cleaning debris that have accumulated on receiving dock floors with a broom takes a long time and just stirs the dust up into the air. To get the job done quickly and efficiently, this process requires a good performing, high capacity wet & dry canister vacuum such as the PC-3, PC-3 on drum or XL 18 Tip & Pour with front mount squeegee.
