- Dilute in cold water at a rate of 1:80.

Spot and Stain Remover: Eco-Expert

Spills, coffee, crumbs, dirt and other debris end up on the seats and carpets. Keeping them clean is a task that must be performed in order to keep stains off the clothing of passengers. A small amount of Eco-Expert will do the trick. UL ECOLOGO Certified.

- Dilute in cold water at a rate of 1:125.
- Available in 4 L & 20 L.

Glass and Chrome Cleaner: Azure

Make sure commuters are satisfied with the condition of the train and let them enjoy the view by keeping your windows, mirrors, chrome and stainless steel sparkling clean and streak free. APE, VOC and ammonia free. UL ECOLOGO Certified.

- Dilute in cold water at a rate of 1:16.
- Available in 750 ml (RTU) & 4 L.
